

In 1984 Father Kelly founded the Congregation of the Daughters of Mary to help provide for the spiritual needs of the faithful. He also made it the Sisters' special work to comfort and console the Sacred Heart of Jesus by making reparation for the sins of mankind, a work which the Bishop understood to be essential for the times in which we live.

On October 19, 1993, Father Kelly was consecrated to the holy episcopacy by Bishop Alfred Mendez. Seeing the destruction of Faith and morals in the wake of Vatican II, Bishop Mendez sought to ensure that the true Mass and sacraments would be available to Catholic people, so he consecrated

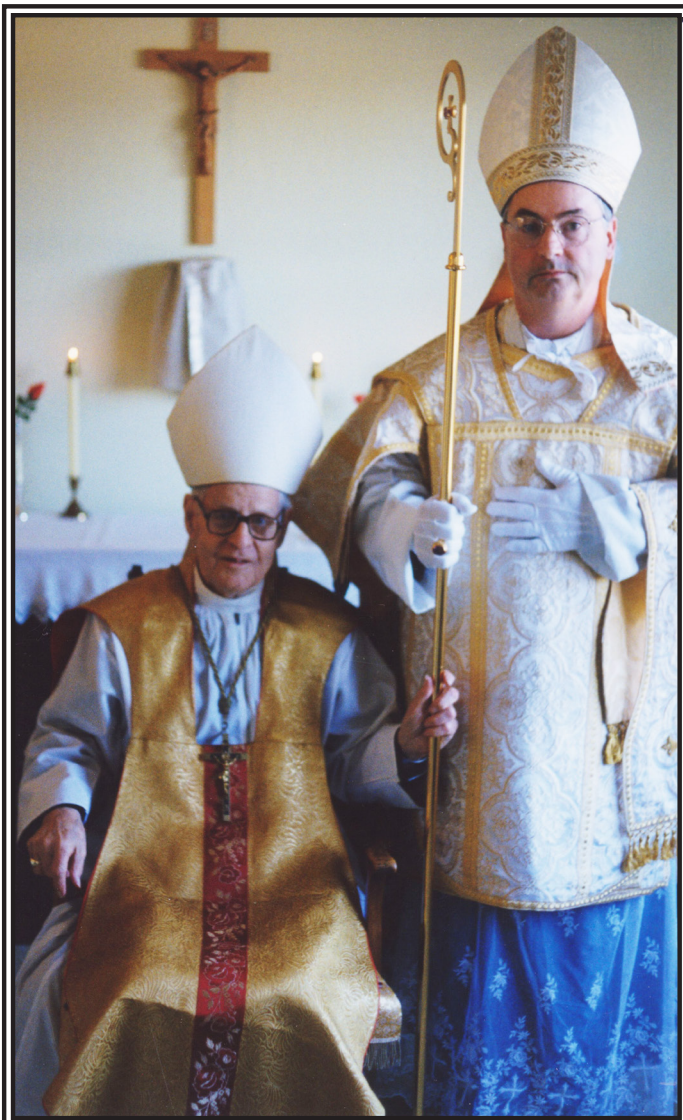
